Sparkle Glaze

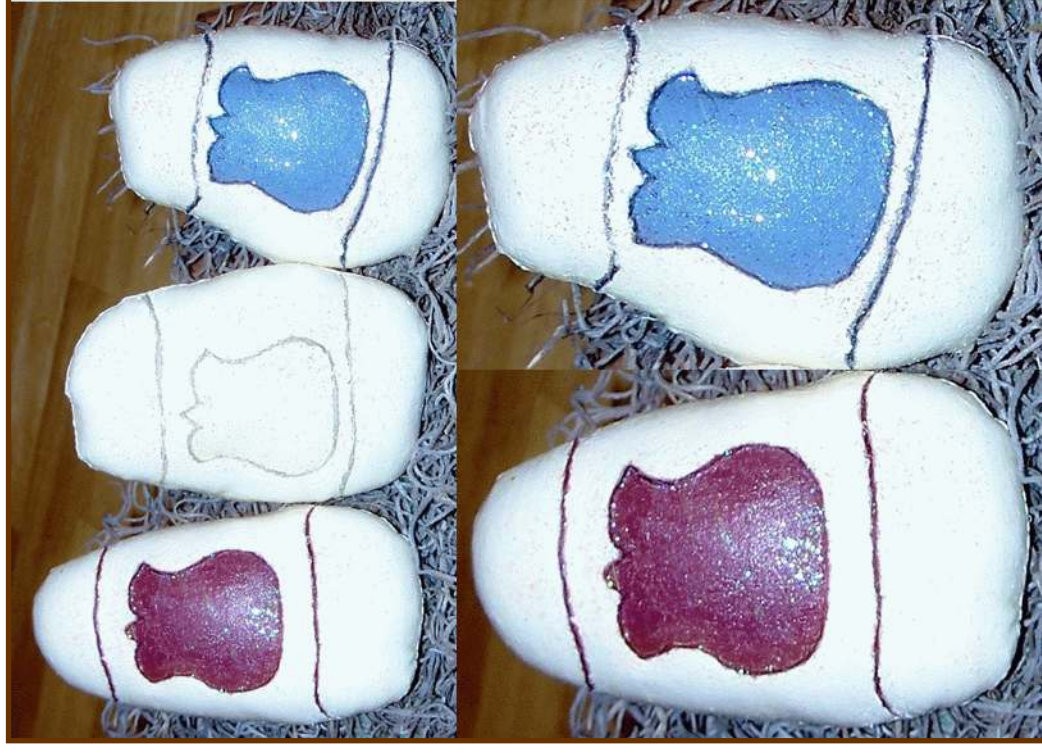

Sparkle Tulip Easter Egg Ornies

Easter Eggs:

#1. Print off the Easter egg pattern and keep pattern for use later. Trace 3 eggs on doubled muslin. Sew on traced lines; do NOT leave an opening. Cut out about 1/4 inch away from sewn lines.

#2. Cut a small slit on back of each egg for turning. Turn.

#3. Stuff firmly and sew openings closed.

#4. Cut the pattern apart, the top on the bolded lines, the bottom on the bolded lines, and the tulip.

#5. Pin these to the eggs in the appropriate places being sure to center the tulip. Trace lightly with a mechanical pencil.

#6. Using a backstitch, embroider each egg (see picture); one with red, one with blue, and one with yellow.

#7. Attach a piece of thread to one end of each egg (to hang for drying.) Using a very small paintbrush, paint front and back of each egg with acrylic antique white paint being sure not to paint the tulip or the embroidery. Apply a second coat. Let dry thoroughly. Sand lightly.

#8. Paint each tulip on the eggs; one yellow, one blue, and one red. Hang to dry.

#9. When thoroughly dry, sand lightly.

#10. Paint with one coat of Sparkle Glaze painting right over the embroidery. Let dry.
